Summary; Lincoln Middle School - Safe Routes to School Project

Background:

Recently, as in preparation for the Safe Routes to School Competitive Infrastructure Grants Program, the Public Works & Development Department initiated a dialogue between the City of Cottage Grove and property owners along the City of Cottage Grove Safe Routes to School Project Area. The property owners were identified by our contracted partner Branch Engineering. The property list provided by Branch Engineering included properties that have potential for needing additional right-of-way to install ADA compliant sidewalks, driveway approaches, and ramps. In total there were 54 properties identified and each received a letter drafted by staff and a one-page flyer describing the project goals and project area (letter and flyer are attached to this memo).

The letters mailed (9/25/2018) to property owners also included an invitation to an open-house hosted by Public Works & Development on October 8th, 2018 from 4:00 to 6:00 PM in Council Chambers. Additionally, staff advertised the open house in two Friday Updates and on the City's website. The letter and flyer were also made available on the City's website.

In the period between the mailing of the letters and the open house staff received a total of 4 telephone calls and two walk-in contacts regarding the content of the letter. Each individual's questions were addressed and to the best of staff's knowledge all parties were left with an understanding of the project and no known barriers as the project moves forward.

The open house was attended by nine members of the community (sign-in sheet attached) with the majority of the people in attendance owning property along the project area. A brief presentation was made to the group with visual representations of ADA ramps, approaches, and sidewalk available for reference. After the presentation the floor was opened for questions. The question and answer session was approximately 45 minutes long and covered a wide variety of topics associated with the project and right-of-way acquisition. In attendance from City staff were Eric Mongan, Ron Bradsby, Ryan Sisson, Faye Stewart, and Amanda Ferguson. At the conclusion of the meeting the City promised to continue the dialogue with property owners as the survey and construction details became available.

The City of Cottage Grove is embarking on an ambitious project to ensure that our young residents have adequate and accessible sidewalks to and from Lincoln Middle School and the new Harrison Elementary School. To make this plan a reality, the City is applying for the Oregon Department of Transportation Safe Routes to Schools Grant. With assistance from Branch Engineering and City staff in the Public Works & Development Department, we have identified your property as potentially requiring a right-of-way purchase. The recognition of your property as potentially needing a right-of-way purchase is an important component of the City's grant application. It is also important for you as the homeowner to understand what this will mean for you and your property as the City moves to make sidewalk improvements in the future with or without funding from the Safe Routes to Schools Grant.

Attached to this letter is a two-page brochure describing the City's proposed sidewalk improvements in the area surrounding your property. Also, you can look at the City's website, www.cottagegrove.org, to view the entire project scope including:

- Maps of the project area
- Photo examples of work to be done
- Project timeline
- Answers to Frequently Asked Question (FAQ's)

Cottage Grove Safe Routes to Schools Project – Right-of-Way & Easement Information


WHO: You and the City of Cottage Grove

WHAT: In 2016, City Council directed City staff to install/repair/replace sidewalks.

driveways and ADA accessible ramps at intersections to provide safe pedestrian travel for school children. The City is applying for the Oregon Department of Transportation Safe Routes to School Grant, which would greatly reduce costs to all parties involved. Additionally, the 1990 Americans with Disabilities Act requires

that cities move toward full compliance with ADA accessibility standards.

WHERE:



WHY: Preliminary design of the project has identified areas where the City of Cottage

Grove may need to purchase right-of-way from some property owners in order to construct the proper facilities to meet ADA standards and City standards throughout the project area. A requirement of the grant mentioned above, is to make contact with property owners where more

right-of-way is possibly needed.

NEXT: The City will be hosting an open house on Monday, October 8, 2018, from

4:00 to 6:00 PM in Council Chambers at City Hall, 400 E Main St.

PROJECT DETAILS:

- 5 foot wide continuous sidewalk system
- ADA Compliance with Surface Standards: tripping, cross-slope, smoothness
- ADA Compliance at intersections, crosswalks
- ADA Compliant driveway approaches

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ'S):

Q. WHAT IS RIGHT-OF-WAY?

A. According to City of Cottage Grove Municipal Code: 12.03.020 Public rights-of-way defined – "Public rights-of-way" include, but are not limited to, streets, roads, highways, bridges, alleys, **sidewalks**, trails, paths, public easements and all other public ways or areas, including the subsurface under and air space over these areas. (Ord. 2789 § 2, 1996)

Q. WHY WOULD THE CITY NEED TO GET MORE RIGHT-OF-WAY IF THERE IS ALREADY A SIDEWALK ON MY PROPERTY?

A. The City's goal is to create a continuous and ADA compliant accessible 5' wide sidewalk within the project area. To meet this standards, addition width will require more space on your property than was originally dedicated. Also, new standards for intersections require additional sidewalk area to allow for maneuverability and proper slope.

Q. WHEN WILL I KNOW IF THE CITY WILL NEED TO PURCHASE RIGHT-OF-WAY?

A. It is the goal of the City to have all surveying completed by the beginning of January 2019, which will allow the City to determine the full extent of right-of-way needed within the project area. After this determination, the City will contact each property owner to negotiate fair and just compensation for the right-of-way.

Q. WHAT IF I ALREADY HAVE SIDEWALKS ON MY PROPERTY?

A. All sidewalks, driveways and intersections in the project route will be evaluated to determine if install/replacement is required for creating a continuous route to the standards listed above.
