June 2019 Building Inspection Services Report

For the month of June the Building Division of the Public Works & Development Department issued 61 permits, two for a new homes and performed 95 inspections in Cottage Grove. In Creswell 17 permits were issued and performed 35 inspections. In Veneta, 21 permits were issued, four new homes and performed 55 inspections. Staff reviewed and approved 32 plan sets in June and an additional 16 plan sets are in review or on hold for additional information from the applicants.

Street Crack Sealing

A rented crack sealer machine and 10 tons (20,000 lbs.) of sealer arrived at the City Shop on Wednesday. Next week the Utility crew will start crack sealing City parking lots and streets. They intend on sealing street cracks Monday through Thursday during July. Please watch out for the crew members as you drive by the work zones.

Curb Painting

Utility staff has spent the last 3 weeks scraping and power washing painted curbs throughout the City. This week the summer hire crew has started hand painting the radius sections of the curbs. Next week they will start using the airless paint sprayer to paint the straight sections of the curbs. Hopefully by the end of next week the curbs along Main Street will be repainted.

Disc Golf Course

This week the last of the downed trees and limb damage from the snow storm was removed from the disc golf course. Staff removed fifty 10 yard dump truck loads and repaired the bike path where an up rooted tree damaged the path.
