October 2021 Building Inspection Services Report

For the month of October the Building Division of the Public Works & Development Department issued 56 permits, 2 for new single family homes, 1 duplex, and performed 85 inspections in Cottage Grove. In Creswell 9 permits were issued, 1 for a single family home, and 67 inspections were performed. In Veneta, 13 permits were issued, one for a new single family home, and 27 inspections were performed. In Coburg 10 permits were issued and 28 inspections were performed. Staff reviewed and approved 11 plan sets in October and 22 plan sets are in review or on hold for additional information.

New Utility Maintenance Worker

Monday Carlos Valladolid started work as a Level I Maintenance Worker for Cottage Groves Utility Division. Carlos worked for the City of Eugene as a summer hire in the Parks and Maintenance Department. The Public Works & Development Department welcomes Carlos and is looking forward to having him on the Utility crew.

New City Planner

Monday Eric Mongan was promoted from Senior Current Planner to City Planner for the Planning Division of the Public Works & Development Department. Eric started his career as a Planning Tech 3 1/2 years ago.
