EDA Main Street Revitalization Project

Excavation of the street and sidewalk on the south side will start shortly. Please use caution while driving through the construction area. There will be a posted reduction of speed to 10 mph in the construction area and a reduction in the lane size. It is very important to reduce your speed and be aware of the pedestrians and workers during this time.

The new fire hydrants have arrived and are starting to be placed. Wildish has completed the water tie-ins on the north and south side of the side streets. City Crew worked with Wildish to pressure test and sanitize the water lines. The Wildish waterline and service work was complete on April 14th. City staff is in the process of attaching the new water lines to the existing one. During this time, there will be water service interruptions. All businesses and residents affected have been notified of the date and times they will be without water.



Concrete pads have been poured and electricity will be installed for the light poles.

The storm drain work started on 8th and 5th Street and will resume on 7th Street next week.

Your patience is appreciated as we navigate through this project. Changes in schedule are inevitable. The City will get the information out as soon as it is made available.
