# **EDA Main Street Revitalization Project**



Excavation work has begun on the street and sidewalk on the south side. Please drive with caution in the construction area. A speed limit of 10 mph has been established, and lane widths have been reduced. It is crucial to lower your speed and stay vigilant for pedestrians and workers in the area. Please be aware that traffic violation fines are doubled in construction zones.

The new fire hydrants have arrived and are being installed. City staff has completed three out of the four new water line attachments. The final

attachments will take place on Monday, the 6th, from 8:30 am to 4 pm. During this time, there will be interruptions to water service. All affected businesses and residents have been notified.

The storm drain work will take place on Main Street between 5th Street and 6th Street. During this time, traffic and parking will be directed to the south side of the street.

Your patience is appreciated as we navigate this project. Schedule changes are inevitable. The City will provide information as soon as it is available.

#### **Cleveland Street Infrastructure Project**

Progress continues in connecting 4th Street to Cleveland Street. Water lines have been installed on 4th Street to Kathleen. On Monday, April 28, crews will begin installing a new water main down Cleveland.

Starting May 1, work will resume on the sanitary sewer line located east of 4th Street.

### FEMA Preliminary Floodplain Map Update

After the successful appeal of the Preliminary Flood Maps, FEMA has released the revised Preliminary Flood Maps for the City of Cottage Grove. These revised maps are available for review in the Community Development office or online at cottagegroveor.gov/cd/page/central-lane-county-flood-map-update.

These new flood maps, officially known as a Flood Insurance Rate Map, identify areas of flood risk (high, moderate, low). These maps will influence financial, planning, investment, and development decisions. Owners of structures in high-risk areas will be required to have flood insurance for loans from federally regulated or insured lenders. We encourage everyone to be aware of their flood risk and purchase flood insurance.
