# **ODOT Bridge Repairs**

Oregon Department of Transportation is repairing two bridges, near mileposts 183 and 169, over I-5 that were recently hit and damaged.

### What to expect:

- Crews working at night from 9:00 pm to 5:00 am Sunday through Thursday.
- Traffic to shift in the I-5 work zones.
- Construction noise and delays.

ODOT plans to start work on September 15 and finish by mid-October.

Some of this work is weather-dependent, and ODOT's schedule may change.

# **EDA Main Street Revitalization Project**

#### **North Side:**

Traffic has been switched to the south side for the entire project length, from Highway 99 to the Main Street Bridge.

Both the 5th and 7th Street intersections remain open for crossing and are operating as four-way stops.

Excavation will resume on the north side. Crews have completed the 8th Street intersection, through the north side of the intersection, to the east side of the 7th Street intersection. Wildish will continue to install the electrical conduits and irrigation. The forming of the curb and gutters, then concrete and sparkle will follow shortly.

#### 6th Street and Main Street Intersection:

The north side of this intersection remains closed as work progresses from 5th to 7th Street. The south side has reopened for left turns both off and onto Main Street.

#### 5th to 6th Street Intersection:

Sidewalk and sparkle have been poured to the Old Club Building. The parallel handicapped parking space in front of the Old Club has been formed.

### City Hall Area:

The sidewalk has been completed to the intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> and Main Street.

Thank you for your continued patience and cooperation as we work to improve our downtown area. We kindly remind everyone to stay within approved areas and avoid entering zones marked with caution tape, as these restricted areas are dangerous and your health and safety are our top priority.
