# **ODOT Bridge Repairs**

Oregon Department of Transportation is repairing two bridges, near mileposts 183 and 169, over I-5 that were recently hit and damaged.

#### What to expect:

- Crews working at night from 9:00 pm to 5:00 am Sunday through Thursday.
- Traffic to shift in the I-5 work zones.
- Construction noise and delays.

ODOT plans to start work on September 15 and finish by mid-October.
