# **EDA Main Street Revitalization Project**

THE 8<sup>TH</sup> STREET INTERSECTION IS NOW OPEN!

The 8th Street intersection is the second completed concrete intersection to open. 6th Street remains open and the 5th and 7th Street intersections continue to be under construction.

Traffic will remain on the south side of Main Street for the entire project length, from Highway 99 to the Main Street Bridge.

#### **NORTH SIDE PROGRESS:**

- The concrete work on the 5th Street bulb-outs and intersection is complete and in the curing phase.
- The bulb out curb and gutter has been poured on 7th Street.
- The sparkle concrete, bollards and broom finish concrete will pour Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of next week (11/24).
- Wildish crew will not work on Thursday (11/27) or Friday (11/28).
- Concrete is scheduled for the first pour of the 7th Street intersection on Monday (12/01); the second pour will be Tuesday (12/02).
- Asphalt will be scheduled for 5th Street and 7th Street once the concrete has cured.
   Approximately 12/09.
- Lantz Electric will continue to attach the electricity to all the light poles.
- Anderson Landscape will continue to work on the irrigation and plantings.

• City staff will work with Wildish on the placement of the benches, trash cans and landscape pots on Wednesday (11/26).

Thank you for your continued patience and cooperation as we work to improve our downtown area. We kindly remind everyone to stay within approved areas and avoid entering zones marked with caution tape, as these restricted areas are dangerous and your health and safety are our top priority.
