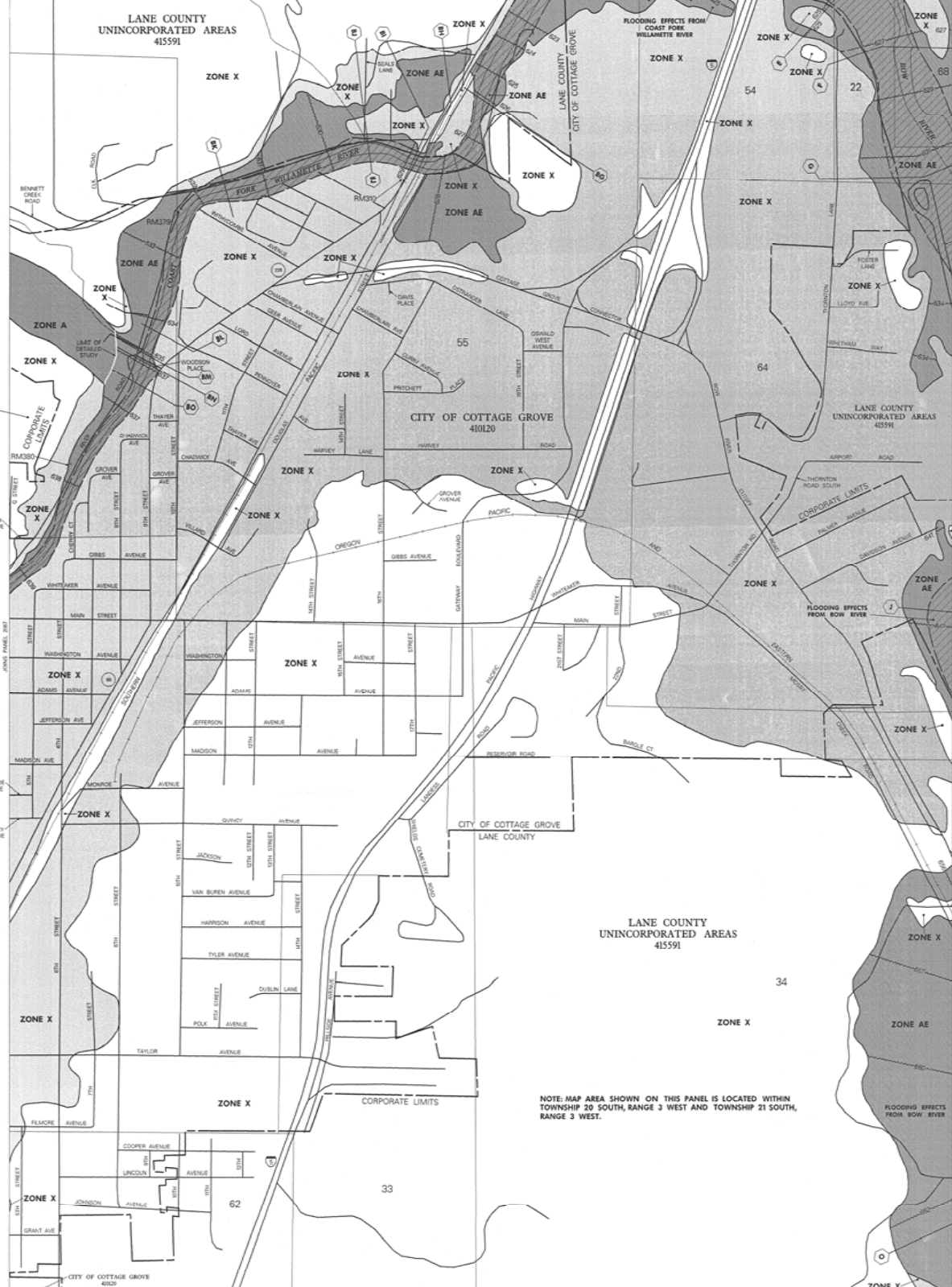


REFERENCE ELEVATION MARK (FEET NGVD)	DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION
RM310 434.56	A disk stamped L 439 1950, located approximately 0.9 mile north along State Route 99 from intersection of State Route 99 and Main Street in Cottage Grove. Disk is in sidewalk opposite post at south end and on west side of bridge over Coast Fork Willamette River. Set by Oregon State Highway Department.
RM377 431.74	Railroad spike in south face of power pole, located at intersection of River and Bennett Creek Roads. Set by CH2M HILL.
RM380 436.81	Railroad spike in east face of power pole No. 28210 located approximately 25 feet west centerline of River Road, 1,400 feet north of intersection of Main Street, between offices to Serrano residence and abandoned school, set by CH2M HILL.



ZONE AH Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet usually about flow in highly irregular channel depths determined. For areas of flood in flooding, indicate as determined.

ZONE AO Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet usually about flow in highly irregular channel depths determined. For areas of flood in flooding, indicate as determined.

ZONE APP To be protected from 100-year flood by Federal flood protection system under construction - no base flood elevations determined.

ZONE V Coastal flood with which hazard near actions; no base flood elevations determined.

ZONE VE Coastal flood with which hazard near actions; base flood elevations determined.

NOTES

This map is for use in administering the National Flood Insurance Program. It does not necessarily identify all areas subject to flooding, particularly from local drainage sources of small size, or all parameters features outside Special Flood Hazard Areas. The community map repository should be consulted for more detailed data. Information and for any information on flood protection should be used of this map for primary purposes of construction purposes.

Areas of Special Flood Hazard (500-year flood) include Zones A, AE, AO, AD, AH, AZ, AB, V, VE and VE-2.

Certain areas not in Special Flood Hazard Areas may be protected by flood control structures.

Boundaries of the flood zones are computed at cross sections and interpolated between cross sections. The flood zones were based on hydraulic considerations with regard to requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

Floodway widths in some areas may be too narrow to show to scale. Refer to Floodway Data Table when floodway width is shown at 500 feet.

Coastal base flood elevations apply only to landward of 50 MGD and include the effects of wave action; these elevations may also differ significantly from those developed by the National Weather Service for hurricane evacuation planning.

Corporate limits shown are current as of the date of this map. The user should contact appropriate community officials to determine if corporate limits have changed subsequent to the issuance of this map.

This map may incorporate approximate boundaries of Coastal Barrier Resources System Units and Otherwise Protected Areas of 1990 (PL 101-501).

For alternate map material, refer to the Countywide Mapping, see Section 8.0 of the Flood Insurance Study Report.

For adjoining map panels and base map source see separately printed Map Index.
