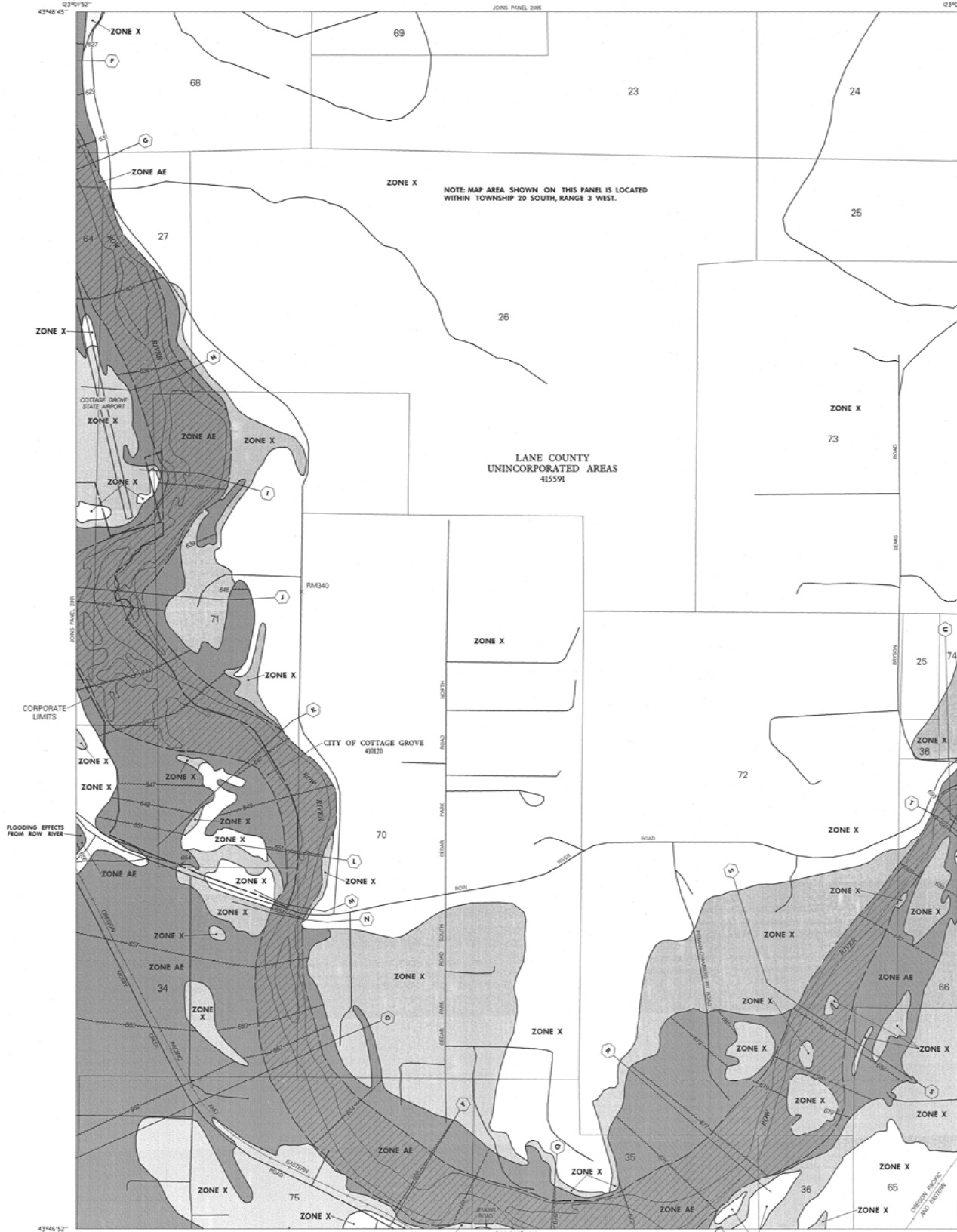


ELEVATION REFERENCE MARKS
 REFERENCE ELEVATION
 MARK (FEET NAVD83) DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION
 RM340 459.16 A railroad spike in west face of
 power pole marked Lane County
 459.16 elevation. TBM No. 7,
 located approximately 45 feet
 northeast of junction of Bear River
 and State Road. Set by Lane County
 (TBM No. 1).



ZONE AH Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet usually above
 ponding; base flood elevations
 determined.

ZONE AO Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet usually above
 flow on sloping terrain; average depths
 determined; for areas of about 100 acres,
 vehicles also determined.

ZONE APP To be protected from 100-year flood by
 Federal flood protection system, under
 construction; no base flood elevations
 determined.

ZONE V Coastal flood with velocity hazard near
 action; base flood elevations determined.

ZONE VI Coastal flood with velocity hazard near
 action; base flood elevations determined.

NOTES

This map is for use in administering the National Flood Insurance Program;
 it does not necessarily identify all areas subject to flooding, particularly from
 local drainage sources of small size, or all parameters. Features outside
 Special Flood Hazard Areas. The community map repository should be
 consulted for more detailed data on DTCA, and for any information on
 floodway delineations, prior to use of this map for property purchase or
 construction purposes.

Areas of Special Flood Hazard (100-year flood) include Zones A, AE, AH,
 AO, and APP, and V, VI, and D.

Certain areas not in Special Flood Hazard Areas may be protected by
 flood control structures.

Boundaries of the floodways were computed at cross sections and
 measured between cross sections. The boundaries were based on
 vertical coordinates with regard to requirements of the Federal
 Emergency Management Agency.

Floodway widths in some areas may be too narrow to show to scale. Refer
 to Floodway Data Tables where floodway width is shown at 100 ft.

Coastal base flood elevations apply only to depths of 0.5 NGVD, and include
 the effects of wave action. These elevations may also differ significantly
 from those developed by the National Weather Service for hurricane
 evacuation planning.

Corporate limits shown are current as of the date of this map. The user
 should contact appropriate community officials to determine if corporate
 limits have changed subsequent to the issuance of this map.

This map may incorporate approximate boundaries of Coastal Barrier
 Resource System Units and/or Otherwise Protected Areas established
 under the Coastal Barrier Improvement Act of 1980 (P.L. 96-380).
