

Appendix L: Potential Grant Funding Sources

Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD) Administered Funds:

Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) assists local units of government and some state agencies, counties, port district, park & recreation districts and Native American Tribes in acquisition of lands and waters or for the development of public outdoor recreation facilities that are consistent with the outdoor recreation goals and objectives contained in the Statewide Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan. LWCF provides funding assistance up to 50% of approved project costs. The minimum federal share can be no less than \$12,500 (\$25,000 total project cost). Local Government Grant Program assists city and county park and recreation departments, METRO, park and recreation districts and port districts with funding for the acquisition, development and rehabilitation of park and recreation areas and facilities. Recreational Trails Program (RTP) provides up to 80% federal funding assistance for acquisition, development, rehabilitation and maintenance of both motorized and non-motorized recreation trails to federal, state and local government agencies and not-for-profit organizations.
