IN CITY

***If you live within city limits,
your taxes pay for your
library card.***

OUT OF CITY

***If you live outside of city
limits, you will need to
purchase a fee card.
\$55 per year or \$35 per year
for ages 62 and older.***

**IF YOU ARE SIGNING UP FOR
A LIBRARY CARD, LIBRARY
STAFF WILL NEED TO SEE A
PHOTO ID, PROOF OF
RESIDENCE AND A VALID
PHONE NUMBER. THIS CAN
BE DONE VIA EMAIL OR A
PHOTOCOPY, WHICH WILL
BE SHREDDED AFTERWARD
TO PROTECT PRIVACY.**

If you are in an assisted living facility, you may have staff assist you with signing up for a library card and/or Books on Wheels delivery.

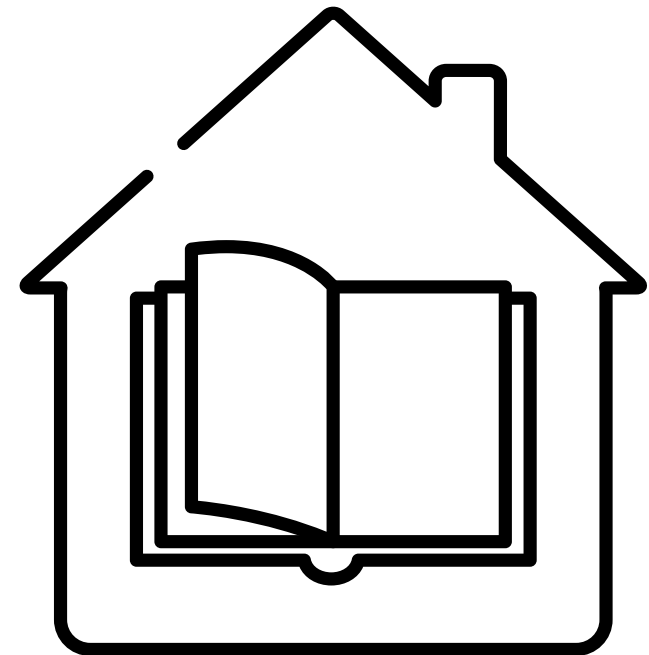

WHO QUALIFIES?

Patrons who are “homebound”: a person who is generally confined to the residence either temporarily, due to illness or accident, or permanently, due to age, disability, or other mobility problems.



WHO DELIVERS?

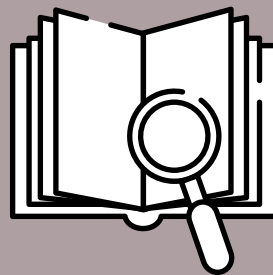

CURATED BY STAFF

On the registration form, you can choose what age level, genre, format and how many items you will receive per month. This helps staff pick materials that fit your needs and preferences.

ASSISTED LIVING

If you are in an assisted living facility, staff may be given permission to help you select materials that will meet your needs and preferences.
