- Rate of pay will be minimum wage, \$11.25 per hour; approximately 20 hours work per week.
- Intern should be from a background representing the diversity of the local community (Spanish speaking required)
- Intern must be able to attend a kick-off event, June 13-15, 2019, in Chicago, IL and a wrap-up event in Washington D.C., September 20-22, 2019. All travel and lodging will be arranged and paid by ALA.
- The Inclusive Internship Initiative program will utilize concepts of “Connected Learning”, which combines personal interests, supportive relationships, and real-world opportunities.
