### Background

A program has been started in Oregon called Home Share Oregon with a mission to "disrupt the housing crisis in Oregon by encouraging and incentivizing homeowners to become a valuable part of the solution. By putting to work underutilized housing inventory, i.e. spare bedrooms, Home Share Oregon intends to expand access to affordable housing one spare bedroom at a time."

### Home Share Oregon

The mission of HSO is to increase access to affordable housing by putting to work underutilized housing inventory, i.e., spare bedrooms. There are 1.5 million owner-occupied homes across the state. A 2% penetration means we can house 30,000 people affordably and create financial resilience for homeowners who may be mortgage burdened.

### Home Share Oregon, Organizational Goals

- A. Culturally normalize home sharing through an extensive education campaign and a compelling public affairs, state-wide outreach program.
- B. Provide direct client support for more vulnerable populations including seniors, individuals and families impacted by natural disasters, homeless youth, and children aging out of the foster care system, etc.
- C. Build a home-owner rapid response program designed to recruit and train homeowners willing to provide housing for families displaced due to a natural disaster (fires, etc.)
- D. Engage in advocacy efforts with local and state governments to pass initiatives designed to decrease barriers to home sharing and incentivize homeowners to join the home sharing movement.

## 2021Accomplishments

The results for 2021, speak for themselves:

- 10,638 Oregonians trafficked our website to learn more.
- 316 homeowners listed their spare bedrooms for rent, decreasing the need for 316 apartments.
- 1,124 renters signed up, many of whom who were more than willing to aid seniors wanting to age in place.
- We were awarded a \$500,000 grant from the state of Oregon, to assist homeowners looking specifically to support fire survivors who lost their own homes, from the disasters this past summer and in just 3 months, 32 homeowners in Lane and Jackson counties have signed up to provide housing to fire survivors.
