SUBJECT: SOUTH LANE COMMUNITY HEALTH CLINIC

Background

Nearly a year ago representatives from the community provided a progress report on the efforts to develop the South Lane Community Health Clinic, a Federally Qualified Health Clinic, in Cottage Grove in the current Lane Community College building on South River Road.

Representatives have requested an opportunity to provide an update on the progress, challenges and the need for additional funding. The update will be presented by Jim Gilroy from Be Your Best with contributions from Eve Gray, Lane County Health and Human Services Director, Margaret Hamilton, President of Lane Community College and Brian McCasline, Assistant Superintendent of South Lane School District.

The City Council adopted Resolution No. 1753 at the July 12, 2010 City Council meeting supporting the designation of the Cottage Grove as a rural site for the Federally Qualified Health Clinic.


