SUBJECT: RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN THE

BUILDING INSPECTION PROGRAM FUND AND THE WASTEWATER

FUND - WASTEWATER TREATMENT DEPARTMENT.

Background

ORS 294.450 allows the transfer of appropriations within a fund. It is necessary to move funds within the Building Inspection Program Fund, and the Wastewater Fund – Wastewater Treatment Department.

The resolution reduces the amount in the contingency line items that correlate to the funds in the same amount. As with any re-appropriation of funds, the net effect on the bottom line is zero.

In the Building Inspection Program Fund, it is necessary to re-appropriate money from the contingency line item to Materials and Services, School Construction Excise Tax line item, in the amount of \$63,000. Construction exceeded original estimates for the year, which creates the need for the re-appropriation to make payment to the school district.

In the Wastewater Fund – Water Treatment Department, it is necessary to re-appropriate money from the contingency line item to Material and Services, Equipment Maintenance and Repair line item in the amount of \$22,880; the Treatment Chemicals line item in the amount of \$64,600, and the Bio-solids Disposal line in the amount of \$37,430. These increases are associated with unanticipated major repairs to equipment, increased costs for treatment chemicals and bio-solid disposal associated with supply chain and transportation costs. The Internal Service Department contingency line item will be reduced by \$125,000 to offset the increase in expenditures.

Recommendation

It is staff's recommendation that Council adopt the resolution to re-appropriate funds within the Building Inspection Program Fund, and the Wastewater Fund – Wastewater Treatment Department.
