Revised Sheets – Sheet C4.0 – *Revision*: ¾"-0 Aggregate base under the sidewalk changed to 1"-0 Aggregate Base. See revision cloud for changes.

Project Manual - Instruction to Bidders Page 4 of 5 - Revision: Section **10** Submission of Prequalification Forms, **Replace** the date of March 29, 2024 with April 10, 2024.

Contractor Question - Will the City or Branch Engineering do the survey and construction staking or is it the responsibility of the contractor? *Clarification*: Construction staking is the responsibility of the contractor, staking is now covered under the bid item #4. Branch engineering has the CAD file available for the awarded contractor.

Contractor Question - Do you have a standard bid bond form that would like to be used? *Clarification*: Yes, the bid bond form that should be used is in the project manual in the statutory public works bond section.

Contractor Question - Will there be irrigation installed for the seed establishment? If not will the contractor be responsible for hand watering until final completion? *Clarification*: There is no proposed irrigation on the project. The contractor will be responsible for hand watering and will be paid in the partial payment percentages shown in the standard specifications for permanent seeding.

Contractor Question – Is the bid item of ¾" Minus rock for under the sidewalks? Does the planter walls get paid under this bid item? *Clarification*: 3/4" Minus rock is now removed from the schedule bid items, 1"-0 is to be used as all the aggregate base under the sidewalk and asphalt. The aggregate for the planter walls is incidental to the bid item 37 - Stormwater Planter, Vegetation, Planter Wall, Aggregate and Perforated Drain Pipe.

Contractor Question – For the stormwater planters, do the walls that run from the curb and gutter to the sidewalk (West to East) get a footing under them same as the walls that are parallel to the curb and sidewalk (North and South)? *Clarification*: Yes, the footings run along the entire perimeter of the stormwater planter walls.

Contractor Question – Do we furnish a certain depth of topsoil in the stormwater planter? Can we use native soil and is there a spec for the seed? *Clarification*: Per the Stormwater planter section on sheet C4.1, there is 18" of growing medium. Per the landscaping sheet L.0 growing medium shall consist of two thirds soil and one-third decomposed organic mulch. The spec for the seed is also on this same page.
